## ITINERARY

### DAY 1: CAPE TOWN

On arrival at Cape Town International Airport you will be met by a representative from Jenman African Safaris, who will transfer you to your hotel. You have the remainder of the day at leisure to acclimatize and relax at the hotel facilities.

### DAY 2: CAPE TOWN

This morning you will be collected and taken on an orientation tour of the city. You will see the Company Gardens, Greenmarket Square, the SA Museum and Bo-Kaap. The afternoon can be spent at leisure. We suggest a visit to the V&A Waterfront, situated in the heart of Cape Town's working harbour, offering an abundance of indoor shopping and entertainment.

### DAY 3: CAPE TOWN

The day is spent exploring the Cape Peninsula and visiting Hout Bay on the Atlantic coast before heading off to Cape Point for lunch. In the afternoon we head back via the Boulders Beach penguin colony.

### DAY 4: CAPE TOWN TO GREATER KRUGER

In the morning you will be transferred to Cape Town International Airport.

Flight CPT/JNB (not included in the costing)

From OR Tambo Airport you will be transferred to Hoedspruit, you will be met and transferred to your lodge situated in the Greater Kruger National Park area. Settle in to your accommodation and spend the afternoon at leisure before embarking on a sunset game drive in the private concession, followed by dinner.

### DAY 5 & 6: GAME ACTIVITIES IN GREATER KRUGER

The next two days will be spent exploring the world-renowned Greater Kruger wildlife area with its diversity of life forms, in search of Africa's Big Five. Keep those cameras ready on game drives in open safari vehicles and/or bush walks and cultural excursions!. During your stay you will have the opportunity to grow your conservation footprint by planting an indigenous or fruit tree in the local community. A complimentary t-shirt is given with every tree donated and leave knowing you played your part in planting the seed of conscious travel.



#### **DAY 7: GREATER KRUGER NATIONAL PARK TO JOHANNESBURG**

This morning after a last hearty breakfast in the African bush, you will be transferred back to Eastgate Airport in Hoedspruit for your onward flight, or transfer to OR Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg (not included).

#### **Reaching the destination:**

A shuttle transfer service is available from OR Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg to Hoedspruit town, Eastgate Airport or designated transfer collection points in close proximity to the lodges (optional and at additional cost). Alternatively, clients may fly in to Eastgate Airport, from where they will be collected by a representative from the lodge. Please note on the Exquisite version of the Kruger Experience, clients can either fly to Skukuza Airport and proceed by vehicle transfer or fly to Sabi Sabi airstrip directly. Flights are not included in the package rate.

***\*Should you wish to overnight in Johannesburg prior or after your stay in Kruger, please enquire with our reservations office regarding possible options.***

**FLIGHTS:**

Jenman Safaris can arrange all domestic and regional flights for this itinerary. Please enquire with our reservations office.

Airport transfers are usually conducted in sedan vehicles or minibuses. The game drives will take place in open 4x4 vehicles.
