ITINERARY

B – Breakfast **L** – Lunch **D** – Dinner

DAY 1: CAPE TOWN - OUDTSHOORN, SOUTH AFRICA

On arrival at Cape Town International Airport, please proceed to the Avis Car Hire depot to collect your hired car and drive to your accommodation in Oudtshoorn, the ostrich capital of the world. The rest of the afternoon is spent on leisure.

Accommodation: La Plume Guest House or similar (rooms with en-suite bathrooms, swimming pool, restaurant)

DAY 2 & 3: OUDTSHOORN - KNYSNA, SOUTH AFRICA

After breakfast, explore the historical Klein Karoo at your own pace and partake in some activities available such as a visit to the show farm to learn about the history and use of these unique birds, as well as their life cycle and how they are farmed or tour the famous Cango Caves - the mysterious limestone formations in the subterranean wonderland.

The next day, drive along South Africa's southern coastline, known as the Garden Route. You will experience a scenic drive to Knysna. you may also like to take a trip to the nearby Monkeyland, where you will get taken on a monkey safari in the forest to learn about these fascinating creatures, ranging from the Gibbons of Asia to the Lemurs of Madagascar. Next door is Birds of Eden, a free flight bird sanctuary, complete with a canopy walk, mysterious ruin and walk behind waterfall. The main attraction is the 220 species of birds that inhabit the aviary.

Distance: 164 km **Departure:** 09h00

Accommodation: The Rex Hotel or similar (rooms with en-suite bathrooms, restaurant)

DAY 4: TSITSIKAMMA, SOUTH AFRICA

Continue your journey along the Garden route via Plettenberg Bay, where you can stop and relax at a stunning beach before making your way towards the Tsitsikamma Forest. Explore the coastal bush and rocky shoreline and if you are more adventurous plunge off the world's highest bungee jump at the Bloukrans River.

Distance: 95 km **Departure:** 09h00

Accommodation: Tsitsikamma Village Inn or similar (rooms with en-suite bathrooms, swimming pool, restaurant and brewery)

DAY 5: PORT ELIZABETH, SOUTH AFRICA

Drive along the costal shoreline the day is spent at your leisure by partaking in optional activities or enjoy the afternoon at the beach.

Distance: 184 km **Departure:** 09h00

Accommodation: The Beach Hotel or similar (rooms with en-suite bathrooms, bar & restaurant)

TRANSPORT:

Avis Car Hire, group B (VW Polo Vivo or similar).

We make use of mid-range typical African standard lodge accommodation. Accommodation is situated either in National Parks, on the banks of a river, or in other places of interest. The accommodation will be a mix of lodges, chalets and tented camps. Most of them have a private bathroom with a shower and toilet. Some properties are equipped with swimming pools and/or bar areas.

MEALS:

Breakfasts will be in restaurants at the various accommodation establishments. Please advise us of any special dietary requirements in advance.

VISAS:

The onus is on the client to organize all visas required to visit the countries stated on the itinerary.
