




SOUTHERN FLAMINGO PACKAGE

(Please note – if you are combining this tour with the 1000 Views of Madagascar, you will join the Southern Flamingo Package from day 10 of the 1000 Views, transferring from Ifaty to Tulear).

DAY 1: TULEAR - ANAKAO	D
-------------------------------	----------

On arrival to Tulear, you will board a boat, which transfers you to the pretty fishing village of Anakao. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure with white sandy beaches and clear water.

Between the months of July and September, you may be fortunate to witness the spectacular Humpback whales during their migration. At additional cost and pre-arranged, you can depart on a motorized pirogue trip to watch these creatures up close. Alternatively optional excursions such as game fishing, snorkelling can also be enjoyed (these must be booked in advance).

Superior Accommodation: Anakao Ocean Lodge or similar (Bungalow with en-suite bathroom)

DAY 2: LAKE TSIMANAMPETSOTSA NATIONAL PARK	BD
---------------------------------------------------	-----------

Today we set out for a day excursion to the Tsimanampetsotsa National Park, where you will have the chance to see 2 of the 4 species of lemurs (2 being nocturnal), the very rare Grandidier's mongoose (endemic to this area only), the Radiated Tortoise, the species of blind fish that lives in the underground caves but most famously, the colony of Greater Flamingos.

Superior Accommodation: Anakao Ocean Lodge or similar (Bungalow with en-suite bathroom)

DAY 3: EXCURSION TO NOSY VE	BD
------------------------------------	-----------

Today you will visit the tranquil island of Nosy Ve - a sacred location to the Vezo people, where each year locals sacrifice zebu according to traditional rituals. The island is home to the world's most southern all-year breeding colony of red-tailed tropicbirds, which attracts ornithologists from all around the world. With excellent sightings of these birds, coupled with stunning white beaches and excellent snorkelling, this island visit will be a highlight of your tour.

DAY 4: ANAKAO - TULEAR - ANTANANARIVO

After breakfast you will be transferred by boat to Tulear and then onto the airport for your flight back to Antananarivo, where your unforgettable tour ends. Note that the flight price is for own account. We look forward to welcoming you to Madagascar again very soon!

PRE-DEPARTURE INFORMATION

DEPARTURE:

Your tour starts in Tulear on day 1, where you will board a boat for your transfer to Anakao. Should you arrive prior to day 1 or already be located elsewhere in Madagascar, pre tour accommodation can be arranged and you will be picked up from your hotel on the morning of day 1.

TRANSPORT:

A 4 wheel drive vehicle is used during this tour.

ACCOMMODATION:

Please note that Madagascar is a country which is in its infancy when it comes to tourism. Accommodation is limited so all the above mentioned accommodation are subject to availability and we reserve the right to change these using similar accommodation of the same standards. The Hotels used are simple & clean and of basic standard, with bathrooms en-suite. Please note that there is an option for an upgrade to a higher standard of accommodation.

CLASSIC OPTION:

Basic hotels: Longo Vezo, Lalandaka Hotel or similar

Please note that due to low water pressure levels in Anakao, most standard hotels do not have running water and offer bucket showers or similar facilities.

SUPERIOR OPTION:

Mid to upper-range hotels: Anakao Ocean Lodge or similar

MEALS:

Where included dinners will be enjoyed in the restaurants of the various accommodation establishments. Please advise us of any special dietary requirements in advance.

VISAS:

A visa is required to enter the territory of Madagascar and can easily be obtained upon arrival at the airport of Antananarivo with a validity of up to 60 days. Tourists staying for less than one month, can purchase a visa for 115'000 Ariary (around 35 €). Paying with the exact amounts or small currency is advised. No photographs are required, however please ensure that passports are valid for at least 6 months after return date.

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

Please note that travel and cancellation insurance is mandatory for every guest travelling with Jenman Madagascar Safaris. All insurance is solely the responsibility of our guests. Please ensure you arrange your own insurance with protection for the full duration of your journey to cover personal injury,

damage and loss of personal items including but not limited to camera equipment and other electronic items, medical expenses, repatriation expenses and loss of luggage, etc. Please speak to your travel agent if you require assistance.
